Any fish species is eligible including largemouth bass, panfish, and mullet, all catch and release.

## AWARDS

Awards will be given for the 1st, 2nd and 3rd longest fish of large mouth bass, pan fish, and mullet caught in each age category. Plus an award for longest "Mystery Fish" caught in any age category and for any tagged fish.

The Grand Champion Award is for the longest eligible fish species overall regardless of age category. The Grand Champion will win a half day fishing trip for two people with Capt. Greg Peralta.

## TOURNAMENT INSTRUCTIONS, RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. The Danziger Cup Kids Fishing Tournament will be held on Saturday, June 14th, 2025 at Smythe Park Lake on Daniel Island. Children ages 4 to 15 related to individuals or families who reside or work on Daniel Island may participate as "Anglers" in the Tournament. Anglers must be accompanied by one or more adults ("Adult") who will register, supervise, and be responsible for the Angler at all times while participating in the Tournament.
2. Anglers must be registered for the Tournament by their Adult supervisor, either by pre-registering online at [www.danielislandfishingclub.com](http://www.danielislandfishingclub.com) or registering at the Tournament. On-site registration will begin at 7:30am on the day of the Tournament. Required Donation: \$5 per Angler if pre-registered; \$10 per Angler for on-site registration. In person registration accepts venmo @DIFish or checks made out to "DIIFF" (no credit cards in person). **ONLY THE FIRST 150 PRE-REGISTRANTS ARE GUARANTEED A GOODIE BAG AT CHECK IN.**
3. Participants are asked to enter Smythe Park at the entrance at the corner of Purcell Street and Daniel Island Drive and proceed to the small island/peninsula. All participants, whether pre-registered or registering on-site must check in at the Registration Table on the island and collect your Tournament Kit. Please arrive between 7:30am and 8:30am for onsite registration and pre-registered check in.
4. Fishing will commence at 8:30am with the sound of one blast of an air horn from the dock on the island. Lines up at 10:30 am with the sound of three blasts of the air horn, after which all participants are asked to gather back on the island for the Awards Ceremony and refreshments.
5. Eligible species for Grand Prize include largemouth bass, panfish, and mullet. All other species caught are "mystery fish". Any tagged fish caught is eligible for a prize/award. ALL FISH MUST BE RETURNED TO THE LAKE ALIVE- STRICTLY CATCH AND RELEASE!
6. Anglers will be grouped in two Divisions: Division 1 - ages 4 to 8 and Division 2 - ages 9 to 15. Awards will be given in each Division for the three eligible species as follows: Champion (longest fish caught), First Runner Up (second longest fish caught by another angler), and Second Runner Up (third longest fish caught by another angler); plus an award for "Mystery Fish" (other species) caught and any Tagged fish caught by any angler. The Grand Champion Award will go to the Angler no matter age who catches the single longest eligible fish by length in the Tournament.
7. To qualify as a 'Catch', fish must be caught on rod and reel or cane pole or equivalent. There is no minimum length to qualify as a "Catch". All fish caught must be measured to the quarter-inch using the DNR ruler supplied in the Tournament Kit and recorded in inches and fractional inches on the Tournament Score Card. If a participant thinks that his/her fish may qualify for the largest fish in any category, it should be photographed against the ruler and available for review in case of dispute. Text your caught fish photo to Brock 202-550-8466 with your: Name, Age & Length of fish. Any tagged fish caught must be shown to a Tournament Assistant before release and recorded as a tagged fish on the score sheet. Tournament score cards must be signed by the Supervising Adult and returned to the Registration Table after lines-up. All decisions of the Tournament Committee will be final.
8. ALL participants are asked to clean up after themselves and to use the trash cans located throughout the area.
